Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As Maryland is starting to reopen, we want you to know that the staff at the Moran Nursing and Rehabilitation continues to work hard to prevent spread of COVID-19 in our facility. At this time, we have no COVID in the facility, and as mentioned in my previous letter, all residents and staff were tested on 5/26 and 5/27 with 100% negative results.

We thank you for your patience and understanding during this pandemic as we have worked to keep your loved ones and our employees safe. Beginning June 17th we will be offering no contact “window visits” with your loved one. We have a visitation space designated next to the front door alcove area. Visitors may sit on the outside bench with a mask and visit with their loved one who will be inside the facility. The window will be open with a screen and plastic covering barrier. Your loved one will also be wearing a mask. Staff will be nearby to supervise the visit.

To accommodate all requests, visitations will be by appointment only Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. We ask you that you call the facility and speak with our receptionist to schedule a visit time. Visits will be limited to thirty minutes and two visitors at a time. There will be a limited number of visits per day due to time needed between visits to clean.

As a reminder, only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
